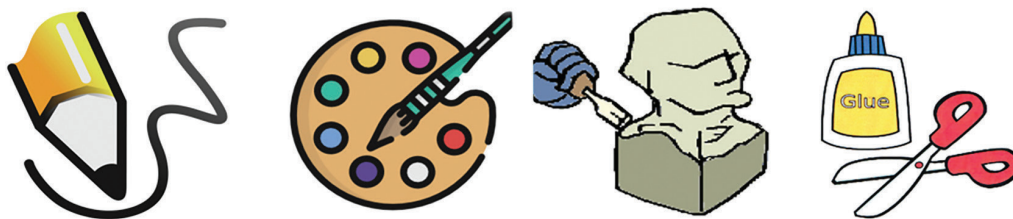

In 2018, the Customs House Museum & Cultural Center received a generous Arts Engagement in American Communities grant from the National Endowment for the Arts. This funding allowed us to offer a series of free art-making experiences called ART 4 US last year during fall break, 2018.

This project is a new community engagement initiative based on the premise that exposure to the visual arts can and should be an edifying encounter for anyone, regardless of skill level, background, age, economic standing, or other perceived barriers to the enjoyment of art.

The hands-on experience of making art is an important project component. During 4 days this spring break, the Museum will offer morning and afternoon workshops led by artists that focus on 4 different media: drawing, painting, 3-D and multi-media.
